Rules & Regulations

Poetry writing competition (24th March 2022)

- The poem should be composed in English/Hindi/Marathi language only for common understanding.
- Each participant will be given a time of 20 minutes for the competition.
- It can be composed in any verse style (Free verse or rhyming).
- The poem must be 24 lines or fewer.
- Use of mobile phones, laptops, and internet will be strictly forbidden.
- A participant can submit only one self-composed poem.
- The written copy of the poem should be submitted to the event co-ordinator(s) on the day of the event for judging.

Elocution competition (24th March 2022)

- Each speaker will be given a time limit not exceeding 5 minutes to speak on the subject.
- A warning bell will be given after 2 minutes and a final bell after 5 minutes. If the speaker exceeds the allocated time then the marks will be deducted at the discretion of the judges.
- The speaker is expected to memorize their speech and is not allowed to read any part of the speech from papers, notes or cards.
- Papers will be awarded based on the following criteria: Content, Presentation, Fluency of the topic, Overall Performance.
- Any use of foul or derogatory language or words will cause disqualification of the participant from the event.

No words poster competition (24th March 2022)

- Each participant will be given a time of 10 minutes for the competition.
- Drawing/painting must be on a white drawing paper sheet. Participants should carry their own drawing sheet and required tools for the competition. The college will not provide any amenity to the participants.
- Acceptable tools of drawing/painting include pencil, crayon, sketch, pastel, water colour, gouache, etc.
- The drawing/painting must not include words or slogans and it must not represent any particular individual, organization, or brand name and must not depict any religious theme.
- Name, class/course of participant and college's name must be clearly mentioned on the back of poster in the English language.
- The theme should be the main focus of the poster. Write the title on the right hand side corner of the poster.
- Neatness will be done on basis of right and clear work as well as idea of drawing/painting.
- The posters should be submitted to the event co-ordinator(s) on the day of the event for judging.

Solo singing competition (25th March 2022)

- Time allotted for each performance is 2-3 minutes.
- No Bollywood or fully used songs will be allowed to sing.
- Participants will not be allowed to refer to the topic while singing.
- The participants will be judged on the song selection, voice quality, clarity, rhythm and their appeal to the audience.
- The participants should bring their own musical instruments if required to the performance.
- Choice of song should not have any slur or derogatory language.

Solo dance competition (25th March 2022)

- Time limit is 2-3 minutes. Negative points for exceeding the time limit.
- No participant will be allowed to perform any Bollywood or fully used songs.
- The participants are requested to carry the file of their song for the dance in a pen drive. Kindly submit it to the event co-ordinator(s) to copy the same in the college system prior to the event before 22nd March 2022.
- The participants will be judged on their attire, visual presentation and dance form.
- Any obscene/offensive music/song is not allowed.
