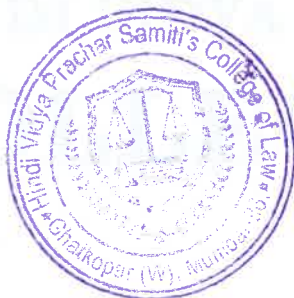

NAVRATRI GARBA – 5th October 2019

A nine-day colourful festival with divine essence and cultural beauty amongst all Indian festivals is Navratri. Hindi Vidya Prachar Samiti's College of Law has now been celebrating 'Navratri-Garba Raas' as the first cultural event of the academic year since 2018-19. On 5th October, 2019; the college quadrangle had an eye-catching sight while being decorated with a roof of colourful ribbons and balloons, flower rangoli at the centre and the beautiful Goddess Saraswati portrait. The event commenced at 6 pm and was anchored by Mr. Naman Sharma (T.Y.BLS) and Ms. Akshata Dixit (S.Y.BLS).
