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Savitribai Phule Jayanti – 3rd January 2020

Birth anniversary of Krantijyoti Savitribai Phule was celebrated on 3rd January, 2020 at Hindi Vidya Prachar Samiti's College of Law with great enthusiasm. The college had organized an "Open Mic" session for all the students of the college, on the subjects of Savitribai Phule's work as a social reformer occasion and her literary writings. Under the constant support and guidance of Hon. I/c Principal, Dr. (Mrs.) Madhura Kalamkar; the teaching staff, non-teaching staff, and the students were present on this occasion.
