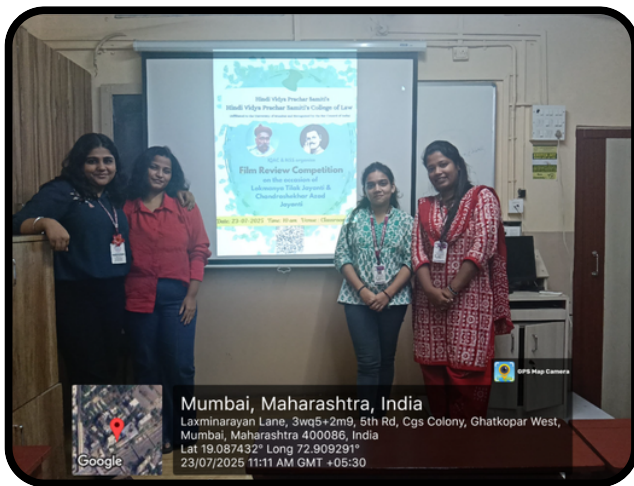
# LOK ADALAT VISIT

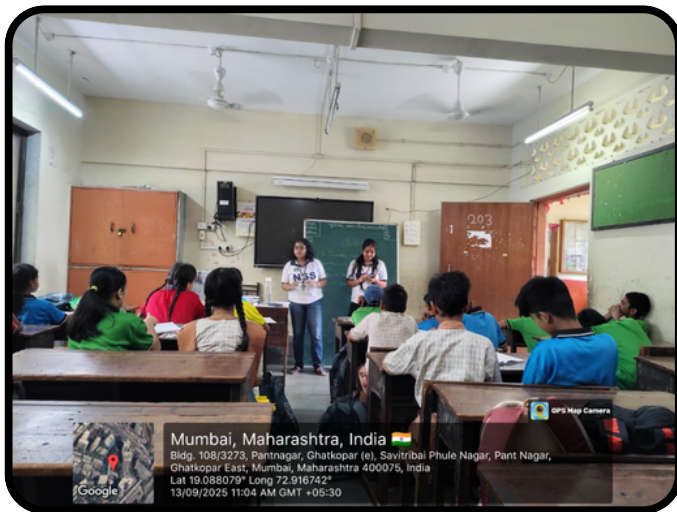

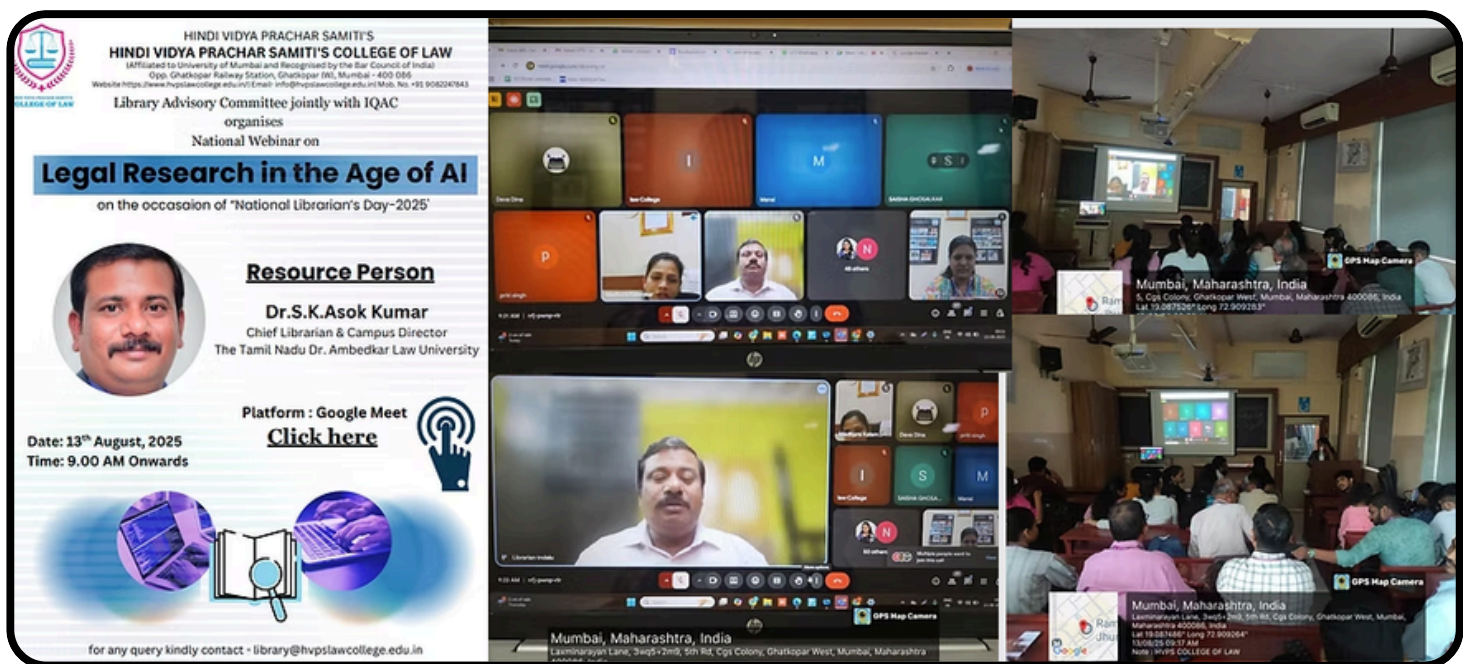

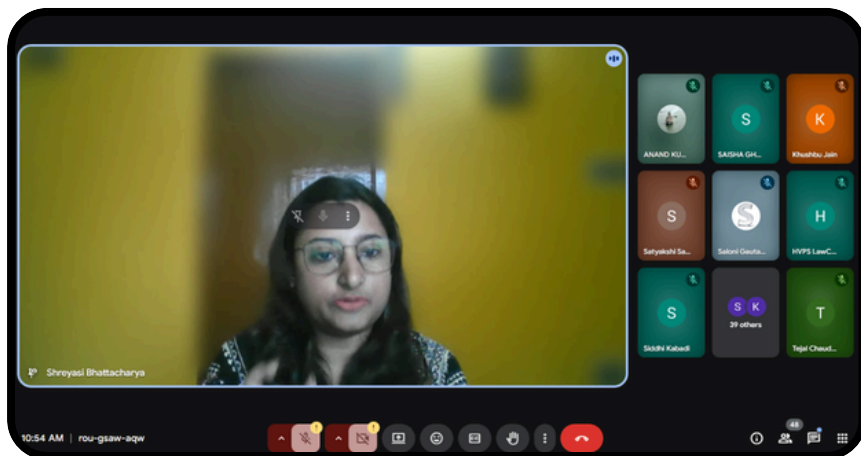
# HINDI DIWAS CELEBRATION
