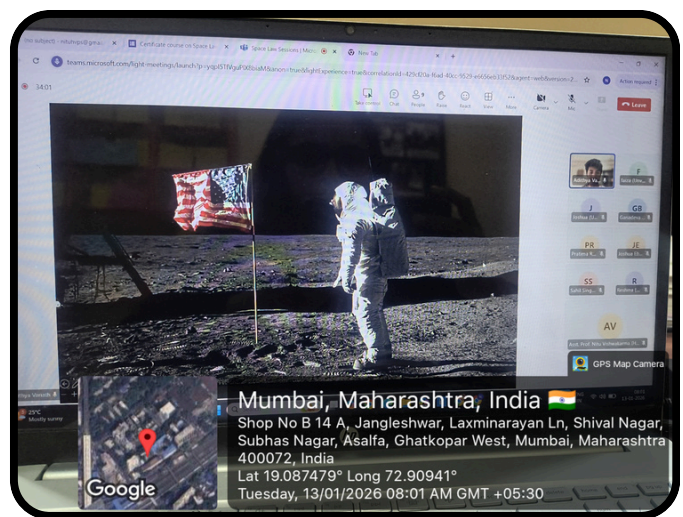
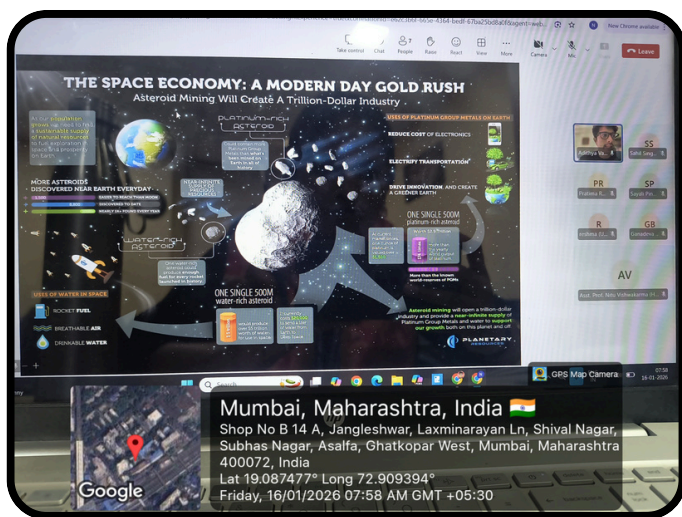
VOTER AWARENESS PROGRAM

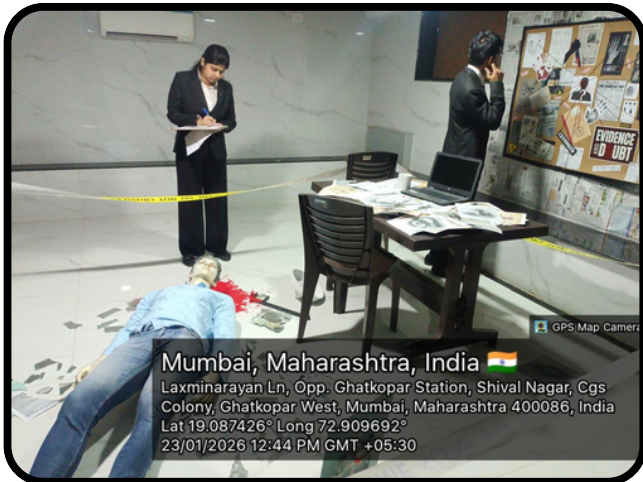
CERTIFICATE COURSE IN SPACE LAW

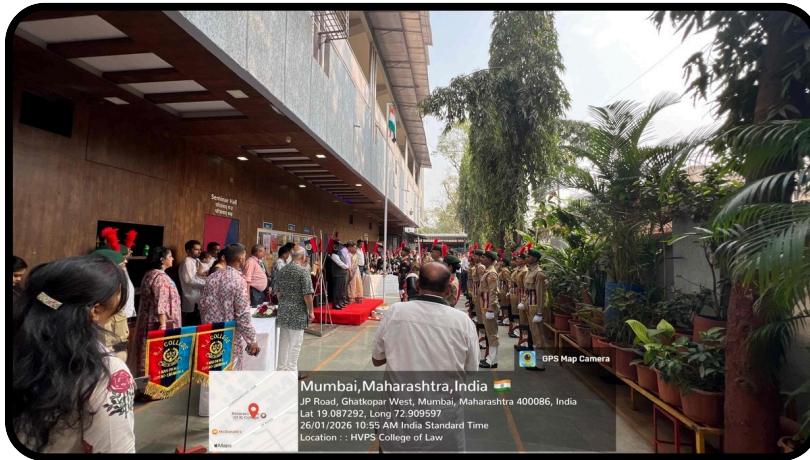
VIDHITAKSHA 2026

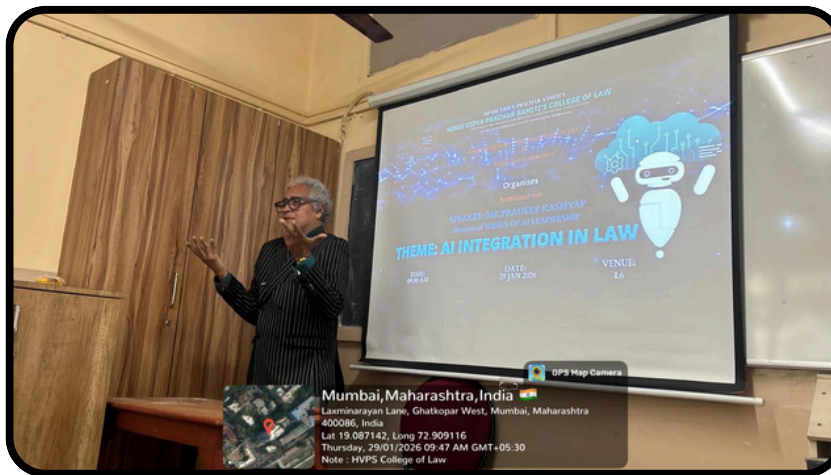
REPUBLIC DAY

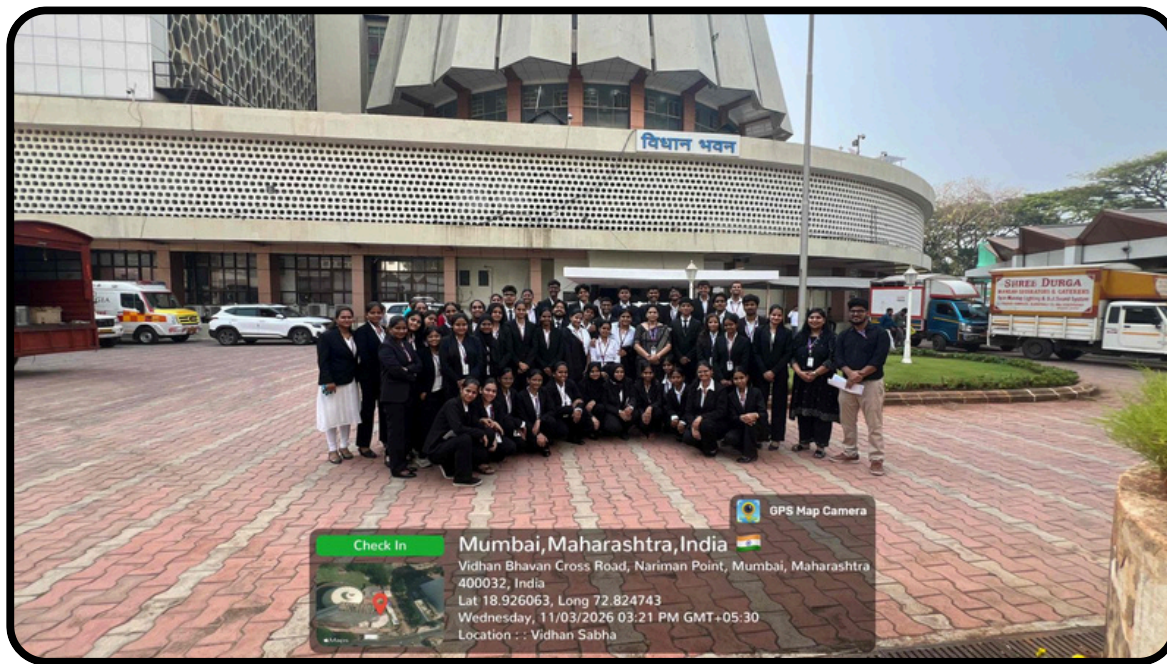
SAKHI - ONE STOP CENTRE
