## Police Station Report

The Hindi Vidya Prachar Samiti's College of Law organized a Police Station Visit for the 1st year LL.B. student as the part of their Practical Training I at Chirag Nagar Police Station, Ghatkopar (West) on 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> January, 2023, with 120 Students divided into 4 batches of 30-30 respectively. The visit was coordinated by Asst. Prof. Tanavi Naik, Asst. Prof. Shriya Prabhu, and Asst. Prof. Sonal Jain. The students were guided by PI (Admin) Mr. Sushant Badgar about the physical structure of a Police Station, nature of duties performed by the Police officers in a police Station, working of the Police Station and students were further briefed by PI (Crime) Mr. Pramod Kokate about the practical aspects of the Cr.Pc procedure and powers of Police. They also answered the questions put forth by the students.

They also explained the students about the procedure to maintain Police Diary, F.I.R, Registration of Cyber Complaint Report and availability of separate lock up for women. During the visit the students are made aware of the functioning of the police station, the role of police in society and the procedural aspects of complaint. The students were also guided by API, Mr. Yashwant Borse, from Externment Department where sir discussed about Prevention methods and role of police in preventing the crime, Ms. Dipali madam, from Cyber Department also discussed about the technology, a boon or bane and different types of Cyber Crimes happening in the society today and measure taken by the authority to curb such organized crime. A discussion with the Senior Police Inspector and other officials in the Police Station helped the students understand the procedure of filing a FIR, the difference between a cognizable and non-cognizable offenses and the role a cop performs in the process of investigation. The student have got the practical knowledge of legal perspective.

The entire session was very interactive and included very informative discussions. The visit proved to be very beneficial to the students who had an enriching learning experience on the practical, everyday functioning of the law
